Plans for Our Next Stage of Ministry

Please continue to pray for us as we seek God's direction for the location of our next stage of ministry, beginning this summer, just after we return from our furlough. In our last prayer letter, we mentioned 2 potential locations. However, after a time of prayer, considering our gifts, strengths and abilities, we discovered that neither one of those ministry configurations would have been a good match for us. So, we went back to "square one," searching through each of the 122 existing Baptist Churches and Ministry Points in Poland. To our daily time of prayer and Bible study as a couple, we added a time for ministry discovery. Which ones would our match our criteria for a potential ministry location? Every day we would research and pray for a church. As we did this seemingly long and arduous task, it enabled us to redefine and reset our criteria. We would like to partner with a young Polish pastor, serving solo in a new and under-developed church that demonstrates an energy or desire to grow. By applying these criteria, we were able to narrow down our search to 14 churches. For 14 more days, we researched one of the remaining 14 churches, learning a little about their

focus and needs. Through this activity, we have been able to narrow down the list to 2 possible locations. Our next step will be to contact the pastors of these 2 churches and set up visits to the churches in order to further determine the Lord's leading and their willingness for us to come.

Story of Hope Great Review

As a conclusion to his weekly lessons from the Story of Hope, Ed led our church in a "Grand Review." Using posters on the walls, small cards depicting the 100 Bible stories, and 8 hand-held posters illustrating the Bridge to Life gospel illustration, Ed tested not only their knowledge of the Gospel, but also their ability to share it with others.

We were encouraged by the positive response. Many asked for copies of the Story of Hope in Polish to share with their unsaved friends and neighbors. One lady is using the Story of Hope in a jail ministry with 12 other ladies. Some asked for the Story of Hope in other languages - including Portuguese and Bulgarian (a copy of which just recently arrived from the States).

"What's the next translation project?" was the other common response to our completion of the Story of Hope. Our next translation project will be the Story of Hope's companion workbook: The Way to Joy. While the Story of Hope is a workbook designed for evangelistic Bible studies, The Way to Joy is intended to be used as a follow-up discipleship study for new believers.



Helping Believers to be On Mission through Prayer

People with a purpose, who are on mission for God, pray and expect God to do great things. Empty jars are mentioned a number of times in the Scripture especially in connection with needs and prayer (see 1 Kings 17, 2 Kings 4). In a recent sermon series Ed used empty fruit jars, to illustrate an important truth: "If we don't pray and expect God's blessings, it's unlikely that we'll receive them." Ed invited people to write out some of their prayer requests - both personal and for the ministry of our church. They placed their requests in the jars and Ed committed to pray along with them for these needs. It has been great to see how God has been answering many of these prayers.

On Radio: Reading Through the Bible

This past week, we participated in Chełm Baptist Church's Annual Week of Reading through the Bible. From early in the morning, until late at night participants from the church and community read all the books of the Bible. Each reader was assigned a time and 3 chapters which they read out loud into a microphone for sound in the auditorium and to be broadcasted on the local radio station. Together we read through the Bible in a week. This event was open to the community and has been well received by the them over the last 5 years. It is a simple, but wonderful means to focus on God's Word in the beginning of the Christmas season.

Did you know?

In the Battle of Warsaw in 1920, when the reconstituted Republic of Poland was not quite two years old, the Soviets attacked Poland, seeking to regain the Polish lands for themselves and Communism. One of the winning strategies used by the Polish military radio-telegraphers was to frustrate Soviet communication by reading the Bible on the same wavelength used by the Soviet commander.
