Visa Renewal

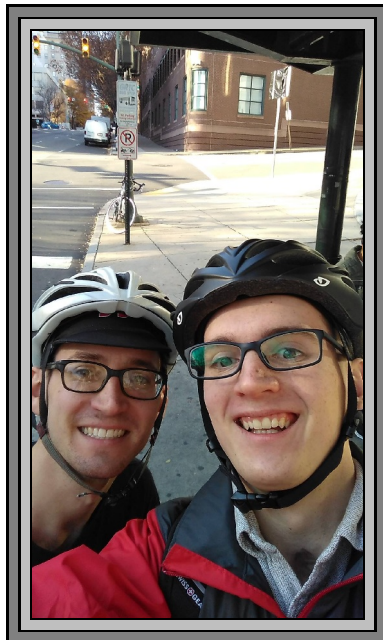

2. Ed & Leslie are team teaching **English Bible lessons** every week with a family. Ed teaches the SOH and Leslie teaches the English.
3. **Story of Hope Translation Project** - Print copy review and corrections.
4. Ed is taking advanced **Polish grammar lessons** Monday through Friday mornings at a local university. Pray for his classmates who are from around the world and most are not believers. Leslie has one tutoring session each week at the university. The students from the language school will be going on a trip to the mountains in early February.
5. **Next Generation Ministry Leaders** - Administrative set-up and funding. Pastors interested in training 200 new ministry leaders.
6. We praise that Lord for **Ryan's progress** and the **new apartment** with Christian. A **special blessing** came to Ryan on Thanksgiving when he noticed his voice starting to return to normal. His therapist later confirmed that the vocal chords they thought would never move again had started to vibrate once again.
7. For **our children** as they study, work and make plans for summer activities and especially **Annelise's pregnancy**.
8. Purchase of a used **car in Poland** along with insurance and registration.
9. Pray for increased **financial support** from those burdened to see the Gospel spread in Poland.
