Furlough Recap

Our furlough was a little shorter this time. We were able to complete one big circuit from Detroit, to Winston-Salem, North Carolina and back again. Here are some of the highlights:

* We gave a presentation at Monclova Christian Academy near Toledo, OH. We reviewed the

story of the Good Samaritan and related it to helping needy Ukrainians. The children were very attentive and well behaved as we helped them to imagine the life of children in Poland or Ukraine.

* During our time in Cleveland, we stayed in the Czech suite of the Panek house which is maintained by a young man who was born in Ukraine.

* We participated in a missions conference at Ambassador Baptist Church in Wadsworth, OH. We helped church members imagine life in Poland. We also enjoyed interacting with other missionaries who were there.



* We visited an elderly lady who was born in Poland and celebrated her 103rd birthday by singing the "Sto Lat" Polish birthday song. We continue to rejoice that she came to Christ a few years ago.

* While we were away, a Ukrainian family was able to use our apartment instead of it sitting dormant as is typical during our furloughs. This family now has an apartment of their own.

* Both Ed and Leslie were able to speak to men's and women's groups. This allowed more personal interaction in sharing about God's work in Poland.

* We are very thankful for the many meals, housing and other blessings that hospitable partners provided during our stay in the U.S.

* In addition to reporting to many churches and individuals, sometimes pastors and church members are able to visit us on the field. We recently hosted Pastor Dave and Melody Ambrose from Heartland Community Church Medina, OH. We toured both ministry and city sites here in Warsaw.



They were able to join with us in a presentation at a local preschool. As Americans we are sometimes called upon to talk about America and American life. We also talked about our role as ministry leaders and how that relates to Christian and American values.

Ukrainian Refugee Aid

We continue to help Ukrainians with their language studies both in Polish and English. This helps them to adjust to life here in Poland and also through these skills they gain more

opportunities in education and business. We've helped two families move to North America. There is one more family that would like to move to Canada. These transitions can be difficult but very fruitful in the longterm. While some immigrants are merely looking for better material opportunities, we are encouraging believing families to see their new home as a mission field to expand Christ's message of redemption from sin.

Leslie has always wanted to play the violin and even brought a violin here to Poland a number of years ago. She has recently started taking lessons from a Ukrainian




believer who used to serve as Concertmaster of the Chamber and Symphony Orchestra in the Rivne Regional Philharmonic in Ukraine. Our violinist friend, Natalia, dreams of once

again playing or teaching professionally, maybe even in the United States. For their first hour together, Leslie helps Natalia learn to teach the violin in English. In their second hour together, Leslie teaches Natalia English using the Ukrainian and Global English versions of the Story of Hope.

Mission Training and Equipping

of Moses raising the serpent in the wilderness, God unfolds his great plan of Salvation to us little by little. It has been a real joy for Leslie to watch these boys discover for the first time how that these stories all fit together into one Big Story of God's provision of a Savior.

Mission Training Group - We were hoping to start a mission training group here in Warsaw with some individuals from our local church and others. Unfortunately, there was not enough interest or commitment to have a formal group that could go through the entire program. So we continue to do what we have done for many years: we use informal interaction to coach believers in becoming stronger in their spiritual lives. We encourage them in their ministries to be focused on Christ-centered goals rather than just merely fellowship and increasing people's knowledge of the Bible or theology. We are also encouraging people to pray about life achievements for which Christ will reward us at the end of all time. It is vitally important that at the end of our lives, we can say we have respected our parents; we have been faithful to our spouse, and that we have taken the opportunity to train children and others to follow the Lord Jesus Christ. These and other important goals are at the heart of our training ministry.

Personal Ministry

A few weeks ago, our neighbor Rodney and his family came over to enjoy for the first time a real, American apple pie. Since moving to this apartment in February of 2020, we had looked in vain for opportunities like this, but God has now finally opened this door for us. Rodney and Margaret were very much open to what we had to say about God and the Bible. This has now become a very positive, ongoing relationship that we hope God will continue to use.

Local Church Ministries

"Blisko Boga" has been without a lead pastor since last September. Ed acts as a helping pastor along with other pastors in sister congregations. We have a rotating preaching schedule which includes Ed, some elders and teachers in our congregation, as well as other pastors who are living in Warsaw but are not currently leading a congregation of their own. Our second-year intern continues to deliver powerful messages. We have had a few new attenders including a family and one single man who have recently come to the Lord.
